



Within the last month, we have made fantastic progress in raising money to restore our #1200 PCRy boxcar. After our End-of-Year Giving Campaign, we had almost \$2,500. Thanks to the Clark Family Trust and a grant from the Dailey

Foundation we have doubled that amount to almost \$5,000. This is a significant advance in our attempt to raise \$11,500 for the complete restoration. We express our gratitude to everyone who donated to the boxcar fund.

Join us as we celebrate the 122nd anniversary of the arrival of the Southern Pacific Railroad to San Luis Obispo in 1894. We will have


